Silverstone Technology Cluster (STC) is a not-for-profit cluster support organisation which started trading on January 1st 2017, founded by Barclays, Buckinghamshire Council, EMW, Grant Thornton, Hexagon, Silverstone Park and West Northamptonshire Council.

Its aim is to support the advanced engineering, electronics and software businesses in the wider Silverstone area (anywhere within roughly an hour's driving time of Silverstone) as a self-funded membership organisation.

The mission of the STC is to create an ecosystem which promotes and supports the growth of its members by maximising the members' national and global competitiveness.

The STC aims to create and facilitate the creation of programmes, groups and events which are informed by the members for the benefit of the members.

Join our community to meet like-minded people and be part of a critical mass of high-tech and business activity in the local area which attracts the attention of government, the finance community and large corporates.

PROMOTION

The STC aims to promote the cluster nationally and internationally, highlighting the power of the network of our highly innovative businesses. To date, STC has hosted several delegations from France, Switzerland, China, South Korea and India next to interest from countries like Italy, Singapore and Malaysia. Significantly, it has also engaged with organisations such as Heathrow Airport, HMGCC, the US Army, DASA and the UK Space Agency, who are all keen for STC to be the conduit to access the problem-solving prowess of the companies in the network.

In addition, STC aids companies within the cluster to promote themselves to each other. As the cluster is uniquely multi-sectorial (motorsport is only around 20% of what the businesses do) bringing companies together and encouraging them to collaborate is a large part of what the STC does.





SUPPORT

The STC's Support stream aims to inform, inspire and support cluster companies with the running of their business, in order to help improve their strategies, management, culture and profitability. In addition, the STC aims to encourage organisations to consider and adopt modern corporate movements like CSR, digitalisation, sustainability and others.

Through its Business Management Group and partnerships with British Business Bank and Amazon Web Services, the STC runs various events to help companies with their growth journeys.

In addition, the STC "Ask the Expert" content series has grown out of its webinar programme and allows members to share their expertise in a variety of topics throughout the year.











TOP SECTORS IN STC MEMBERSHIP (%)
